Substrates

12"x 12" Panel (gessoed) - smooth surface such as MDF, hardboard, or wood (one for each project)

- Brushes for acrylic application-large and medium size cheap house - paint or craft brushes, small roller by ArtMinds
- Brushes-bristle brushes, and soft brushes sizes 0-6. I like Robert Simmons and Isabey brushes.
